Annexe: Brincliffe House, 59 Wostenholm Road, Sheffield, S7 1LE

Directions (map and photo overleaf)

The front window of number 59 has Brincliffe House printed on it.

There is a bell for Cornerstone on the **right** hand side of the green front door, marked Cornerstone.

Please aim to arrive at the time of your appointment, as there is no reception-cover.

The therapy room is up one flight of stairs. There are toilets available.

By Bus:

The number 3 bus, which runs every 10 mins., can be taken from the City Centre, at the top of The Moor, on Furnival Street. The stop is just down from Debenhams, on the same side, if you walk towards Eyre St/Arundel Gate from Debenhams (opposite the Rocking Chair pub). Get off the bus on Wostenholm Road – it is the stop *after* the Sharrow Lane stop. Walk back a few yards to find number 59 on the same side of the road. The return bus stop is across the road, and to the right, about 100 metres towards town.

By Car:

From the Ring Road (Hanover Way/St. Mary's Gate)

- Take Ecclesall Road A625.
- After pedestrian light take left filter at next traffic light into Summerfield Steeet.
- At next traffic light (Nuffield Gym on left) continue straight ahead into Washington Road and then to next crossroad/traffic light. You will see some flats painted bright green on your left.
- Continue straight on into Wostenholm Road.
- Number 59 is on the left, just after the third left turning, on the left hand side.
- There is a red post box immediately opposite and a bus stop just past the building on the left.

From Abbeydale Road

- Take Sheldon Road to the Nether Edge cross roads/traffic lights.
- Turn right into Moncrieffe Road.
- At the roundabout turn right into Montgomery Road, which becomes Wostenholm Road.
- About 400 metres from the roundabout, number 59 is on the right hand side.
- There is a red post box immediately opposite 59 and a bus stop on the same as 59.

Parking

There is usually on-street (free) parking on Wostenholm Road and surrounding streets within a hundred metres or so (e.g. Steade Road, Thornsett Road, Kenwood Park Road).
